

RESERVATION AGAINST USE OF BIOLOGICAL MATERIALS COLLECTED IN THE HEALTH SERVICE FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES WITHOUT CONSENT

The Health Research Act entered into force on 1st.July 2009.

Pursuant to § 28 of the Act, the Regional Committees for Medical and Health Research ethics (REK) may approve that medical research studies of great social significance use biological material collected from patients in the health service without having to obtain consent from each patient.

The law presupposes that the patient must have been informed that human biological material can in certain cases be used for research and must have been given the opportunity to make a reservation against research on human biological material § 28 in the Health Research Act

By filling out this form, you withhold consent for biological material collected from you during treatment and diagnostics can be used for research without obtaining consent for such use.
